Questions & Answers

Who can participate? Anyone over the age of 18 who can dance comfortably at the bronze level. You should have no experience or limited experience dancing silver level steps.

What dances will be included? Students will learn a routine in the following dances with all the styling: (*Smooth*) Foxtrot, Tango and Waltz, *Latin (Rhythm) Swing* Rumba and Cha Cha

When and Where? Classes will meet once a week on Mondays for 45 minutes. Classes will be held in various studios in the Metro Boston Area.

Who will teach me? Dance classes will be taught by Bill Morganti. Bill is a local dance teacher, Judge, and one of the organizers of the U.S. Eastern Dancesport Championships.



Bill Morganti has been teaching students and training dance professionals around the world and in the Boston area for over 30 years. During that time Bill has performed, taught and been interviewed on major area television stations such as Channels 2, 4, 5, and 7. He is an adjudicator with the National Dance Teachers Council of America, The World Dance & Dancesport Council and a National Examiner for Dance Vision Inc. Dance Association. Bill has also been seen judging reality dance show Ballroom Boot Camp on TLC
