## Questions & Answers

**Who can participate?** Anyone over the age of 18 can participate. You should know the basics in the six different dances and of course bring a positive attitude.

**Do I need a partner?** No partner is needed. Students will be paired up as the course develops. You are welcome to enroll with your own partner.

**What will I learn?** Dancesport series students learn an intermediate bronze level routine in the following dances with all the styling : Foxtrot, Waltz, Tango, Rumba, ChaCha, Swing.

**When and Where?** Classes will meet once a week for 90 minutes. Classes will be held in various studios in the Metro Boston Area. By using different studios you will have the opportunity to observe studio life and the dance community

**Who will teach me?** Bill Morganti is a local dance teacher, Judge, and U.S. Eastern DanceSport Championship organizer. Instructional DVDS, Videos, and CDS are also available for purchase through Dance Vision.

**What does it cost?** The only fee is \$110.
